

## Commercial Pilot License (CPL)

The EASA Commercial Pilot License course is the last step towards becoming a commercial airline pilot.

The aim of this course is to train the PPL(A) holders to the level of proficiency necessary for the issue of a CPL(A).

<b>TRAINING / EXAMINATIONS</b>	25 hours flight training 20 hours Single Engine 5 hours Multi-Engine
<b>LICENSE ISSUE REQUIREMENTS</b>	License skill test
