Candidates who have completed the Private Pilot Licence and are looking to undertake a Commercial Pilot Licence will need to have completed a minimum of 162 hours flight time. Course Structure

During your Structured Hours Building you will typically complete:

Flying Hours to reach minimum 162 hours prior to CPL training
1 in 10 hours free flight supervision from our instructors

- situational awareness
